A Message From Our DIRECTOR

Treatments options and hospital facilities are becoming increasingly more sophisticated. With each passing year in the United States, children and adults have access to more effective treatments and better medications. The good news is that more and more patients are surviving diseases, injuries, and conditions that we previously incurable. The sad news is that these patients rarely receive treatment for the psychological and emotional effects of undergoing the challenges and treatment of an illness.

As a mother of a child born with multiple congenital birth defects, I can personally speak to the importance of emotional well-being during the healing process. My son Miles has undergone more than 50 surgeries, and together, we have spent countless nights in the hospital. Despite his trials, Miles has maintained a sunny, positive outlook on life, even when life wasn't easy for either of us. Every parent of a medically challenged child shares that moment of feeling out of control of the situation, and I will never forget mine. Miles was four, and after a very difficult surgery, I found myself hovering over his still body, desperate for a sign that he would be okay. Hope comes from the most unexpected sources, and I remember the sheer joy I felt when, from beneath the hospital sheets, his little thumb emerged to me the signal "I'm good Mom". Thumbs up, he was saying, it's going to be okay.

Thanks to supporters like you, 2020 marked our 25th year providing "Miles of Smiles" and joy to children in need. It was a year like no other, adjusting to a Pandemic and getting creative in raising funds so that we could commit to our Shadow Buddies programs. We stand strong in our mission to continue to provide Shadow Buddies to thousands of children and their families in need.

Our Mission of Charity and Hope

The mission of the Shadow Buddies Foundation is to provide emotional support through education regarding illness, disability, or medical treatments. The foundation accomplishes this through unique programs designed to enhance the lives of children and adults. In pursuit of that mission, the foundation will continually raise funds, develop new programs and build relationships between organizations with complimentary goals.

The Shadow Buddies Foundation is dedicated to providing support and knowledge to children with severe illnesses, disabilities, and going through a crisis situation. The Foundation accomplishes this through unique programs designed to enhance the lives of children and adults by fostering compassion and awareness of differences with our line of 36 condition-specific "Shadow Buddy" dolls. Crafted from muslin and carefully researched to represent a child's medical condition, Shadow Buddies offer children the companionship of a friend "just like me". Each year our goal is to deliver approximately 40,000 Shadow Buddies worldwide with 5,000 of the Buddies staying locally in Kansas City.

Pink Parties

Launched in 2010 at the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta-Scottish Rite, the Pink Party is quickly becoming one of our most sought after programs by Child Life Specialists and pediatric hospitals throughout the United States. Currently Pink Parties are being held in Kansas City and hosted by numerous sponsors such as Sporting Kansas City. We've been honored to partner locally with Children's Mercy Hospital here in Kansas City and support the Turner Syndrome Clinic hosting three parties a year supporting precious girls diagnosed with this disease. Each year, we continue to host parties in seven different states across the country. And we don't forget about the mother's, grandmothers, sisters, aunts or any other caregivers who are always by the girls' side, they get pampered too! Our Pink Parties include make-up, hair, nails, and fun crafts. Each girl is given her very own Shadow Buddy complete with a tutu.

Superhero Program

In 2015, in celebration of our 20th anniversary, we launched the Superhero Shadow Buddy Program giving children the power of extra strength, courage, and love to fight their battles. Every Shadow Buddy that was delivered or donated, came with a Buddy sized Superhero Cape and mask. Working with children every day, we see how powerful their own Superhero Buddy helped get them through a tough day and treatments. With the success of this program, we expanded the Superhero Program to include the children themselves, giving them a child sized cape and mask to match their Buddy.

16,000 Superhero Shadow Buddies delivered to patients and 7,000 Pediatric Superhero Capes and Masks distributed to children.

Summer Backpack Program

Each year, we provide more than 1,000 Backpacks to special need camps around the country. Shadow Buddies are donated to specialty camps to help ease the first day jitters by welcoming the special campers. Endorsed by camp counselors and nurses at the camps, the buddies are used to teach children about their medical condition and promote a positive image. Shadow Buddies Backpacks are loaded with all the camp essentials that include fun activities for boys and girls, toothbrush, comb, water bottle and of course, a specific Buddy for each camp! Their Buddy is a year-long reminder of the new friendships they made at camp. Funds raised from our Golf Classic and other private donations support our Backpack program.





Courageous Crew

In 2020, the Shadow Buddies foundation introduced our new "Courageous Crew" Buddies. These Buddies came at the perfect time for us to support and thank our real community Heroes. These five buddies include a Police Officer, First Responder, Firefighter, Physician/Nurse, and Military/Veteran Buddy. The purpose of these Buddies are used to comfort both the children of these public servants who are forced to be away from their families for extended periods of time, as well as for the "Courageous Crews" members as they interact with children in traumatic circumstances. Our mission is to support the families of these real Heroes who spend time away from home each day serving the front-line in our communities a make it a safer place. Our goal is to continue to highlight and support this program for years to come.

Fantasy Flight

Many children dream of traveling to the North Pole to meet Santa, Mrs. Claus, and all the elves. In 2018, Shadow Buddies partnered with United Airlines to host the first Fantasy Flight since 2001. Taking place in December of each year, and with a little Christmas magic, over 50 terminally ill and medically challenged children receive their boarding passes with a destination to the North Pole. Accompanied by a parent, these special children board a United Airlines 737 airplane greeted by the pilot and his flight crew dressed for this special occasion. Once they take off and fly around the city for 45 minutes, other family member and countless volunteers wait for the children to land and enter the North Pole. . . which has been turned into a winter wonderland in a separate location in the terminal straight out of a story book. Greeted by Mascots, choirs, Superhero's, and princesses, Santa makes a grand entrance with his motorcade and Secret Service. Lots of goodies to eat, activities, and excitement for the entire family is provided for this special holiday event. Each child and their siblings received a huge bag of toys from Santa and a special Shadow Buddy that has been wrapped with love and donated from businesses in the community. The North Pole and Holiday Hugs toys that are provided to medically challenged children is made possible from our wonderful volunteers, staff, board members and an amazing partnership with United Airlines.

Holiday Hugs Program

In October of each year, we kick off our annual "Holiday Hugs Toy Drive Program" that provides thousands of toys, Shadow Buddies, and dinner to hundreds of Kansas City metro families. We team up with local businesses to collect toys for the holidays that will then be distributed to families, shelters and other like-minded non-profits that are passionate about helping medically challenged children and families in need during the holidays. In addition to the Fantasy Flight families, we adopt close to 350 additional families in our community with gift bags of toys and goodies. This past year in 2020, we had such an over-whelming response from our Board Members and community businesses collecting toys, that we were able to donate in addition to the families we sponsored, \$10,000 worth of toys the Pediatric Department at the University of Kansas Medical Center. We were honored to escort Santa and Mrs. Claus to the hospital via motorcade with local Federal Agents, KCK Police Department and the Fire Department. This year we truly sprinkled lots of magic and granted holiday wishes to children in our community. Even the Grinch couldn't stop Santa!

Each year the Miles Award is presented to a deserving Individual, Board Member, or Volunteer in our community. The Miles Award that stands for: MAGNIFICENT - INDIVIDUAL - LENDING - EXTRA -SMILES named after co-founder Miles Postlethwait. Celebrating our 25th Annual Gala was a little different in 2020, as we had to get creative and held our first virtual auction due to the pandemic. Shoot for the Kids - A Clay Target Event

Launched in 2016, the "Shoot for the Kids" a clay target event is one of the most thrilling events put on by the Shadow Buddies Foundation. Each year, teams from around the Kansas City metro area come together to raise money for our "Courage Capes — Capes for Kids" program. Our goal is to raise \$30,000 that allows us to support medically challenged children battling life-threatening conditions and going through various medical treatments. Our "Courage Capes" provide children with a child size Superhero Cape and mask and allows them to do play therapy and become the hero they truly are while battling their medical condition. This is a sell-out event and a great day of food, friends and a fun on the course.

Golfers enjoy a day filled with lunch, cocktails and a silent auction.
