Buddy Specs:

- Buddy comes with a soft blanket to help comfort the child in need
- Buddy comes in light, medium and dark skin tones.
- Hair color is either Blond (B), Black (BL), or Brown (BR).
- On medium and dark skin tone Buddies, hair is black. If hair color is not indicated with order, we will mix the order.
- Weighing approx. 10 oz., the buddies are 15" high and meet FDA requirements.

Rescue Buddy

Our goal is to equip every emergency vehicle with a unique tool to improve pediatric care right from the beginning, Shadow Buddies to the rescue! Rescue Buddies are supplied to children who come in contact with EMS personnel through illness, injury or who are simply scared due to the emergency situation. The Buddy quickly calms the child and enables them to focus on something which makes it easier for the



EMS to start assessing and begin treatment. It also helps the EMS team with their own jitters, since working on little people can be intimidating when you don't deal with them on a daily basis. Rescue Buddies speak all languages. A simple hug is all it takes.
